2. Information or service vendors are welcome.
3. If food items are sold, you will need a food permit. The food permit must be seen by the NWIAAA before the event. It may be scanned or emailed to the above email address.
4. Tables will be provided (rectangle 30x70 6ft).
5. Breakdown is at 6 pm, no earlier
6. Funds are nonrefundable unless the NWIAAA cancels the event.
7. Do not block visibility from other tables with large displays.
8. Each vendor will donate a small prize for raffle tickets. Vendors may also buy tickets.
9. Proceeds of the fair go toward the NWIAAA operational budget.
10. Open Mic (reciting poetry, song, musical instrument entertainment) no cost.
11. Open Mic time (2 pm – 6 pm).
